### **AERTEC Solutions attends Passenger Terminal Expo as an aeronautic engineering expert in Airports**

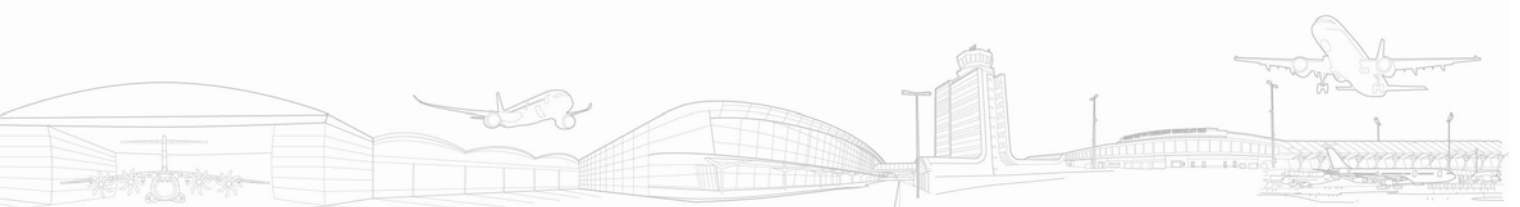
- The multinational engineering and consulting company specialised in the airport sector shows its skills as expert in airfields, having developed projects in different airports worldwide.

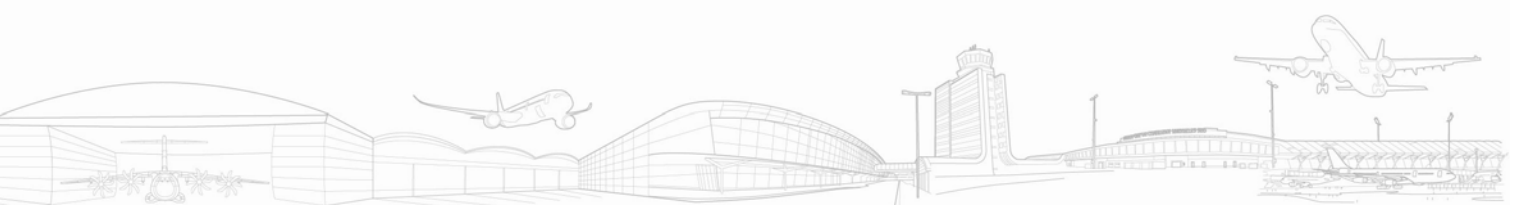
